## Adjudicators/ Master Class Clinicians

CHRISTINE BRANDES: Noted soprano Christine Brandes performs at many of the world's most distinguished festivals and concert. She has sung principle roles for the following opera companies: San Francisco, Seattle, Washington National, Houston Grand, Minnesota, New York City Opera, Philadelphia, Glimmerglass, Portland, among others. She has also sung with the following orchestras: Cleveland, Chicago, New York Philharmonic, Philadelphia, Los Angeles, San Francisco, Houston, Atlanta, Detroit, Seattle, Minnesota, National Symphony, with such distinguished conductors as Sir Simon Rattle, Pierre Boulez, Esa-Pekka Salonen, and Nicholas McGegan. Christine recently appeared with West Edge Opera (Oakland) in Martin y Soler's L'Arbore di Diana; the Boston Symphony Chamber Players in György Kurtág's Scenes from a Novel and Handel's Israel in Egypt at Carnegie Hall with the New York Choral Society. As a conductor, Ms. Brandes has led operas by Haydn and Rameau for Victory Hall Opera (Charlottesville) and Gluck's Orfeo ed Euridice for West Edge Opera. She is an Associate Professor of Voice and Opera at San Francisco State University, director of the UC Berkeley University Baroque Ensemble and assistant conductor of the Oakland Civic Orchestra.

AMY JARMAN: Soprano Amy Jarman has been hailed by the Los Angeles Times for her "radiant tone and moving phrasing." She is an active performer, appearing in opera, concert and oratorio performances at universities and music festivals in the U.S. and abroad. Ms. Jarman has been a guest artist at the Vocal Artistry Art Song Festival in Albuquerque, N.M., the Festival of American and Bulgarian music in Sofia, Bulgaria, the Baroque Festival of Corona del Mar, California, the Dame Myra Hess Concert Series in Chicago, and the Rocky Ridge Music Festival in Estes Park, Colorado. Jarman has appeared in concert in London, Leeds, Manchester, and Bristol, England and given master classes on American art song at the Royal Northern College of Music and the Guildhall School of Music and Drama. She is on the voice faculty at the InterHarmony Music Festival in Acqui Terme, Italy. Ms. Jarman has sung roles as diverse as Mímí in La Bohème, Countess Almaviva in The Marriage of Figaro, Desirée Armfeldt in A Little Night Music, and Madeline Mitchell in Jake Heggie's Three Decembers. Jarman is a member of the voice faculty at Vanderbilt University's Blair School of Music.

NICHOLAS MUNI: Nicholas Muni is in his fourth year as Artistic Director of the A.J. Fletcher Opera Institute and Professor of Music at the University of North Carolina School of the Arts. He has also recently been appointed as Artistic Director of More Than Musical, Ltd, a new opera company in Hong Kong. His productions have been seen at San Francisco Opera, New York City Opera, Canadian Opera Company in Toronto, Houston Grand Opera, Seattle Opera, Los Angeles Opera, Glimmerglass Opera and Opera Theater of St. Louis. In Europe he has directed for the Prague National Opera, the Kurt Weill International Festival, Stadttheater Giessen, Opera Ireland, Theater Erfurt, Tirolerlandestheater in Innsbruck and Stadttheater Bern. He served as Artistic Director for the Tulsa Opera (1987-93) and Cincinnati Opera (1996-2005). Recent projects include: Norma at The Dallas Opera and Florida Grand Opera, The Kiss of Tosca and La Traviata at More Than Musical Hong Kong, Crazy in Love at Opera Hong Kong, ConcertArt at UNCSA, Lucia di Lammermoor at The Academy of Vocal Arts, Impressions de Pelléas, Florencia en el Amazonas and La Tragédie de Carmen at A.J. Fletcher Opera Institute, The Seven Deadly Sins at Tanglewood Music Center, Don Giovanni at Opera Philadelphia and San Diego Opera, Elektra at Michigan Opera Theater; Powder Her Face at Odyssev Opera in Boston. Don Pasquale at San Francisco Opera Merola Program. Upcoming projects: Exotica with Opera Hong Kong Young Artist Program, Le Nozze di Figaro at Miami University Opera, and Norma at Calgary Opera.
